

II.—CHARTERS CONNECTED WITH GRANTS OF REGALITIES AND THE GENERAL TITLES OF THE EARLDOM.

1601. Charter by James the Sixth, in favour of John (6) Earl April 29. of Sutherland, by which the Charter of Regality, granted by David the Second in favour of his nephew, William (3) Earl of Sutherland, and dated at Lanerk 10th November, 1345, was confirmed and extended by the annexation of Strathnaver, Edderachylles and Durness and other lands, to the Earldom and Regality of Sutherland, by the erection of Brora into a Burgh

of Regality, and by the creation of the hereditary Sheriffdom of Sutherland.

*Contract between King Charles I. and John Earl of Sutherland,
for the resignation of the Regality of Sutherland.*

1631. July 18. Aug. 26. CHARLES R. AT Oatlands and Halyrudhous respectively the auchteeene day of July and twenty six day of August, the zeir of God One thousand six hundred and threttie-ane zeiris. It is appointed, agriet, finallie contractit and endit betwix the most excellent heich and michtie Prince and Monarche Charles, be the Grace of God, King of Scotland, Ingland, France and Ireland, defendar of the Faith, and with advyse and consent of His Majestie's richt traist Cousigne and Counsallour Williame Erle of Mortoun, Lord Dalkeith and Aberdour, and Heiche Thesaurer, Comptroller, and Collectour-Generall of His Majestie's new augmentationnis within the kingdome of Scotland, and of His Majestie's traist Cousigne and Counsallour Johne Lord Stewart of Traquair, and His Majestie's Deput in the saidis offices, and also with advyse and consent of the Lordis and utheris of His Majestie's secreit Counsal and Excheker of the said kingdome of Scotland on the ane pairt, and His Majestie's right traiste Cousigne Johne Erle of Sutherland, Lord Strathnaver, on the uther pairt, in maner, forme, and effect as aftir followis:—That is to say, FOR SA MEKILL as umquhile Johne Erle of Sutherland, father to the said Johne now Erle of Southerland, was heritable infect and seaset be Chartour and Infectment, grantit to him under the great Seall by his Majestie's umquhile darrest father King James the Sext of worthie and eternall memorie off the dait, the penult day off Apryll, the zeir of God 1601 zeiris, and Instrument of Seasing following thereupon, adittit the day of , In all and haill the richt and priviledge of Regalitie within the haill boundis off the Erledome off Sutherland, in maner at lenth mentionat and contenit in the said Infectment lykeas umquhile King David the Secund, His Majestie's predecessor of worthie memorie be his Chartour and Infectment of the dait at Lanerk, the tent day of October, and seventene zeir of his reyne, gave grantit and confirmet to umquhile Williame Erle of Sutherland, and to His Majestic's sister Margaret spous to the said Erle, and to thair airis, to be gotten betuix thame (of quhome the said Johne, now Erle of Sutherland is lineallie discendit) the said Erledome of Sutherland in ane friegyalitie for ever with all liberties, commodities, easmentis, and

richteous pertinentis which are known to perteine to ane frie regalitie as amplie and surelie as any regalitie within the said kingdome of Scotland is bruikit and possest, and sicklyke for sa meikle as the said umquhile Johne Erle of Sutherland, be vertue of the forsaid Chartour and Infectment grantit be His Majesties said umquhile darrest father of the dait forsaide, and Seasing following thereupone, wes heritable infect in all and haill the heretale office of Scherifship of the Scherifdome of Sutherland comprehending the boundis and limitis specifiet in the said infectment. Lykeas be the said Infectment the said umquhile Erle and his airis, mail and of taillie specifiet and contenit therein, are maid and creat not onlie heretale Schereffis of the said Scherifdome, but also heretale Crownaris of the samyn Scherifdome, and in the saide Chartouris and Infectmentis of the daitis respectively above writtin at mair lenth is contenit, AND als forsamekill as the said Johne, now Erle of Sutherland wes upone the seventene day of Apryll, the zeir of God 1617 zeirs dewlie and lawfullie infect and seaset as air to the said umquhile Johne Erle of Sutherland, that last deceaset his father, In all and haill the said richt and privieledge of frie regalitie within the haill boundis of the said Erledome of Sutherland, with the haill privieledges, liberties, commodities, easementis, and richteous pertinentis of the samyn, And also in all and haill the saidis heretale offices of Scherifship and Crownarie of the said Scherifdome of Sutherland with the haill liberties, privieledges, and immunitiess of the samyn within the haill boundis thereof, as the said Infectment of the dait forsaide at mair lenth purports. AND His Majestie being fullie resolvet to have all the heretale offices and jurisdictionnis within this kingdome drawen and reducet to the Crowne and prerogative royall in the maist easie, just, and commodious way, and His Majestie upone some offeris and overtouris maid be the said Johne now Erle of Sutherland, for surrandering of the saidis heretale offices in His Majestie's handis for ane reasonabill satisfacioun having remittet the consideration thereof to the Commissionaris of Surranderis and Teynds, They be thair Act of the dait the 17 day of Junij, the zeir of God 1631 zeiris, have fund the saidis offeris and overtouris reasonabill in thameselves, and according thairto ordanet His Majestie's Advocat to draw up ane perfyne and formale resignationoun of the saidis offices and richtis of Regalitie, Scherifship, and Crownerie

to be subscrybet be the said Erle, togidder with suche writtis and securities as may secure the said Erle in the possessioun of the saidis richtis and offices untill the composition and summe aftir specifiet extending to the summe of Ane thousand punds sterlinc, be reallie and trewlie payit be His Majestie to the said Erle, hes airis, Executors, or Assignayis, THAIRFORE the said Johne now Erle of Sutherland, for obedience and fulfilling of his pairet of the said Act, binds and obliessis him and his forsaides to resigne, renunce, surrander, and overgive fra him and his forsaides, in the hands of His Majestie and His Hienes' successourris, and in thair favour all and haill the said heretale richt and titill of Regalitie, togidder with the saidis heretale offices of Scherifship and Crownarie of all and haill the said Scherifdome of Sutherland, with the haill fees, priviledges, liberties, commodities, and immunitiis perteyning and belonging thairto, togidder with all and sundrie chartours, preceptis, seasingis, infestmentis, and other richtis, titillis, and securities quhatsoevir maid and grantit to the said Erle, his predecessours and authoris, or conceivet in thair favour be quhatsumevir persoun or personoues of and concerning the said heretale richt and titill of Regality forsaide, and of the saidis heretale offices of Sherefschip and Crownarie, liberties, priviledges, and casualties perteyning thayrto, togidder with all richt, titill, interest, clame of richt, propertie, and possessioun, petitory, and possessory, actiouen and instance which the said Erle or his forsaides had, hes, or ony wayis may have clame or pretend thairto, or to ony pairet thairof, in time cuming, reserving allenarlie to the said Erle and his forsaides, the libertie and priviledge of Baronn Courtis, pit and gallous, with the jurisdiction of Baronie, liberties and priviledges of the samyn within so manie of the landis, baronies, Erledome and Schereffdome forsaide, quhilk the said Erle and his successors holdis, or sall hold of His Majestie, and His Hienes' successors in frie Baronie, and no further, and for the better denuding of the said Erle and his forsaides of the heretale richt and titill of regalitie and heretale offices of Schereffship and Crownarie abovespecifiet with the priviledges and casualties perteyning thairto, the said Erle hes maid, constituted, and ordanet, and by the tenor heirof, makis, constitutes, and ordaines James Douglas maister to the secreit counsell and Exchekker, and ilk ane of thame conjunctlie and severallie,

the said Johne Erle of Sutherland, his verie lawful, undoubtis
 and irrevocable procurators, actors, factors, and speciell earand
 bearers to the effect underwrettin, gevin, grantand, and commit-
 tande to thame, and ilk ane of tham conjunctlie and severallie, as
 said is, his verie full, frie, plaine power, generall and speciell com-
 mand, express bidding, mandat, and chaire for him in his name,
 and upone his behalff to compeir befor Our Soverane Lord and
 His Hienes' successours immediat lawful superiours of the said
 richt of Regalitie, offices of Scherifship and Crownarie above spe-
 cifieth, or before thair Commissionaris, quhatsumever day or
 dayis, place or places, lawful and convenient, and thair with all
 dew reverence and humilitie as becomes purelie and simplie be staff

 diat, lawfull superiours of the samyn. IN FAVOURIE OF His Majestie,
 and His Hienes' successours forsaidis ad perpetuam remanentiam
 To remaine with thame for ever Reserving allenarlie to the said
 Erle and his forsaidis, the libertie and priviledge of Baronn Courtis,
 pit and gallous, with the jurisdictione of Baronie liberties and
 priviledges of the samyn within so many of the landis, baronies,
 Erledome and Scherifdome forsaid quhilk the said Erle and his
 successours holds, or sall hold, of His Majestie and His Hienes's
 successours, in frie baronie, and no further actis, instrumentis, and
 documentis, ane or mo thairupone, to ask, lift, and raise, And ge-

nerallie all and sundrie uther thingis to do, use, and execute anent the premissis siclyke, and as freiely in all respectis as the said Erle micht do thairin himselff if he were personallie present, promittend to hold firme and stabill all and quhatsumever thingis his said procuratours or ony of thame conjunctlie and severallie in his name in the premissis richteouslie dois, Quhilk surrander and resignatioun the said Erle binds and obleissis him and his forsaids to warrand, acquyet, and defend, to be guid, valid, effectuall, and sufficient in the selff, fra his awin and his forsaids proper factis and deedis and fra the proper factis and deedis of his predecessours, Erles of Sutherland allenarlie AND His Majestie, with consent forsaid, willis and declaris that efter the payment of the said summe of Ane thousand pundis sterling, efterspecifiet, quhilk is appoynted to be payit to the said Erle and his forsaids for the prycce and compoition of the surrander of the forsaidis heretable richtis and offices, that the said richt and titill of regalitie sall be supprest and extinguisched for ever With the haill priviledges, liberties, commodities, and casualties perteining and belonging thairto ; But as to the said jurisdiction of Scherifship and Crownerie his Majestie willis and declaris that the samyn sall be onlie supprest and extinguisched in swa far as the samyn are heretable, but not in swa far as the samyn are severall jurisdictions and offices necessar for the governement and peace of the Kingdome, quhilk his Majestie willis and declaris to stand in the awin force and effect with the lyke priviledges and liberties as perteines to onyuther Scherifdome of this Kingdome not being heretable, AND farder, His Majestie considering how necessar it is that the said Countie of Sutherland, togidder with the landis efter following, lying maist ewest and contigue thairto be of new established in ane haill and frie Scherifdome, to be governet be thair awin Scheriffis and uther officiaris requisit to that effect. THAIRFORE His Majestie with advyse and consent of the saidis Lordis and utheris of His Hienes' secreit counsall and exchekker of this said kingdome, HES of new erected and incorporat, and by the tenor herof of new erectis and incorporatis, all and haill the said countrie of Sutherland with the countries of Strathnaver, Assint and Fairniecostar, alias Sleischeles, with the haill boundis, landis, baronies, erledomes, Lordschips, waters, fischingis, mylnes, and utheris, within the samyn. IN ANE HAILL, frie, severall and distinct Scherifdome be the selff To be

callit now and in all tyme cuming, the Scherifdome of Sutherland to be goverнет by the Scheriffis and utheris officiaris perteyning to the jurisdiction of ane Scherifdome in all tyme cuming. Lykeas His Majestie with advyse and consent forsaid of certayne knowledge and proper motive, disunits, dissolvis, and dividis the said landis and countries of Assint and Fairniecostar alias Sleischeles quhilk for the present ar ane pairt of the Scherifdome of Innerness in respect of the far distance thairof fra the Burgh of Innerness quhilk is the heid Burgh of the said Scherifdome of Innerness, and unites, annexis, and incorporatis the saidis Landis and Countries of Assint and Fairniecostar alias Sleischeles, with the haill boundis of the samyn To the said Scherifdome of Sutherland, in respect of the neirnes and contiguitie thairto, and commodiousnes of the samyn. Lykeas His Majestie with couenant forsaid of certayne knowledge and proper motive for His Hienes and his successors, willis and ordaines that the said Scherifdome of Sutherland comprehending the haill lands and boundis quhilk of before perteynet to the said Scherifdome of Sutherland, and are exprest in the said Infectment grantit be his Majestie's said umquhile darrest Father to the said umquhile Johne last Erle of Sutherland in the moneth of Apryl, 1601 zeiris Togidder with the saidis landis and countries of Assint and Fairniecostar now addit thairto sall be and remaine ane severall and distinct Scherifdome be the selfe separat frome the said Scherifdome of Innernes in all tymecuming within the boundis and limitis efter following, vitz. And the said lands before and after mentioned of the **BARONY OF ARDURNESS** and teind sheaves of the same, which were formerly held of me, the said Marchioness and Countess, and my predecessors in feu, with clauses de non alienando for payment of the feuduty after mentioned and performances of the personal services of hosting and attending me the said Marchioness and Countess, my predecessors in all Parliaments to be held in Scotland, now of me, my heirs and successors in simple feu by virtue of the Act of Parliament of his Majesty, King George the First, entituled, "An Act for more effectually securing the peace of the Highlands of Scotland," and by virtue of the other Act of Parliament above mentioned. And all and sundry the lands, milns, fishings, teinds, and others above mentioned, are now holden of me the said Marchioness and Countess, my heirs and successors, in feu farm and heritage; GIVING therefor yearly the said George Granville, Marquis of the County of Stafford and his foresaids, to me the said Elizabeth Marchioness of Stafford and Countess of Sutherland, and my heirs and successors, the feu farm duties and others underwritten. To wit for the foresaid lands of **RIBIGILL** and others before expressed, which were formerly held, taxed ward, the sum of five shillings and four pennies Scots money, in name of feu farm duty, and freeing me the said Marchioness and Countess, and my heirs of the yearly duties and other debts of feu farm money, if any such be payable or demandable by any person forth of the foresaid lands of Ribigill, Sandwood, Island of Hoa, Aschourbeg, and Aschourmore, and also freeing and relieving me, the said Marchioness and Countess, and my heirs of all taxations imposed or to be imposed by our Sovereign Lord the King, on the foresaid lands, and that for all other burden, exaction, demand, or secular service that may be exacted or required forth of the lands, fishings, and others foresaid in any manner of way. And for the foresaid fishings on the water of Garn-

rone, Ardbeg, Ardmore, Aschourmore, Aschourbeg, Carumanoeh, Sandwood, Kearvag, Havish, Kealdale and salmon fishings upon the water of Duirness, and cruives thereof; Cromgillicle, Borlie, Slamanis, Balnakiel, Forret, Gavell, Crossbell, Balnamullick, Sandgaves, Ylandhoan, Rispyne, the sum of Eighty-four pounds Scots money, at the term of Martinmas yearly, as the ancient feu duty, payable out of the same, and of the further sum of Twenty-four pounds Scots money of feu duty at the term of Martinmas, yearly, as the value and in lieu of the personal services before mentioned, and of the clauses de non alienando, wherewith the Investitures of the foresaid **BARONY OF DURNESS**, and teinds of the same were formerly burdened, and DOUBLING the foresaid sums of Eighty-four pounds and Twenty-four pounds Scots, the first year of the Entry of each Heir to the foresaid Lands and Teinds, and relieving me, the said Marchioness and Countess, my heirs and successors, of the sum of Forty shillings Scots money, which we are bound to pay to our Sovereign Lord the King for the foresaid Lands and Teinds of the foresaid Lands and Barony of **ARDURNESS**, yearly at two terms in the year, Whitsunday, and Martinmas in Winter, by equal portions, and Sicklike, freeing and relieving me, the said Marchioness and Countess, my heirs and successors of all ministers' stipends, annual rents, burdens, and taxes imposed or to be imposed upon the foresaid fishings on the water of Garnrone, lands of Ardbeg, Ardmore, and other lands and fishings aforesaid, for which the said sums of Eighty-four pounds and Twenty-four pounds of feu duty are payable and on the aforesaid Teinds, Sheaves of the Lands and Barony of Ardurness, and with power and liberty to me, the said Marchioness and Countess, and my heirs and successors of hunting once every year in the foresaid forest of Diriemore and Durness, without any stop or impediment, Sicklike as freely and with such privileges as the predecessors of the said George Granville, Marquis of the County of Stafford, have at any time bye past hunted, or the said Marquis hereafter shall hunt, within the same. As also that the said George Granville, Marquis of the County of Stafford, and his foresaids, shall be bound and obliged to accompany and attend me the said Marchioness and Countess, and my foresaids during the time of our hunting in the said forest of Diriemore and Duirness, if thereto required upon premonition of twenty-four days, and if it shall

happen theforesaid feu duty of One hundred and eight pounds Scots to run for two years into the third unpaid, then and in that case the said feu duty of three years shall be doubled, and if the payment of the said feu duty shall run for three years into the fourth unpaid, then and in that case this present Charter, so far as concerns theforesaid lands of the Barony of ARDURNESS and Teinds thereof with all that may follow therein, shall thenceforth become null and void, as if the same had never been granted, and that without the necessity of any other process of declaration to be raised hereupon, and that for all other burden, exaction, demand, or secular service that may be any ways exacted or required forth of the towns, lands, islands, waters, fishings, and teind sheaves aforesaid, saving always and reserving my own right and the right of all others, as accords of the law. And I consent to the registration thereof in the Books of Council and Session, therein to remain for preservation, and to that effect I constitute, &c.

Resignation by Donald Macourchie of lands in Milness and Hope, as the descendant of Farquhar Leiche to the King, in favour of Eye McKy and his son.

Note—This Ferchard or Farquhar is thus noticed in the original Statistical Account of Scotland, vol. vi. page 293, under the head of Edderachyllis—

"All these islands from Roe-a-Stoir in Assint to Stroma in Orkney, were granted to one Ferchard Beton, a native of Isla, a famous physician, at his own request, by one of the Stewarts, Kings of Scotland, whom he had cured of some distemper. This Ferchard was physician to the Mackays of Far, who gave him in exchange for these islands, lands near Melness, opposite Tongue—the possession of which they recovered long since, yet it is said that some of his posterity remain still (1793) in the country under the name of Mackay."*

Being desirous to learn if any such tradition still existed, I begged of the late Mr. George Taylor to ascertain how this was, when he visited Melness in the course of a Tour which he was then (1831) making.

The inquiries which he then made led to the following interesting account. He found that the name and the reputation of the physician was still known. His skill was thus accounted for—from his reading, he learnt, that if a white serpent could be caught and boiled into a liquid, the possessor of that liquid would acquire the faculty of curing all diseases; his learning warned him at the same time that the serpent must not be caught or the liquid prepared by the person who was to obtain this wonderful gift—and further, that whoever caught the serpent, and

prepared the liquid, was not to be informed of the object of that in which he was employed.

Ferchard accordingly placed a youth who was in his service at the place where the serpent would appear. He was instructed to touch none but the white serpent—ten serpents were allowed to issue from the hole uninjured, but the eleventh being a white one, was caught, boiled, converted into a liquid, carefully corked up in a phial, and delivered to the physician. The youth was immediately sent out of the country.

Ferchard in possession of this precious liquid made many cures.

Mr. Taylor was also informed that Ferchard was celebrated for curing the toothache by administering the juice obtained from the bark of a tree which grew in a corner of the garden at Melness, and some of the older people said that they had some recollection of the bark of a tree being used for medicinal purposes. Mr. Taylor carefully examined the garden, where no tree then grew (1831), and he discovered the remains of an old ash tree, the stringent bark of which, no doubt, was used with advantage in curing the toothache.

Having thus ascertained the prevalence of this tradition in the parish of Tongue, on the northernmost shores of Scotland, it became a question of more than ordinary curiosity to learn whether any traces of a similar tradition existed in Isla—also Ferchard's reputed birth place; which fact was established in a remarkable manner, through the kindness of Mr. Campbell of Isla, who wrote to his factor, forwarding several queries that I put into his hands. That gentleman reported to Mr. Campbell that there existed several traditions concerning Beton, the King's physician. The following is the substance of the most interesting.

He stated that the belief was, that about the year 1370 an Englishman named Cockspur having been on a visit to Isla, "was murdered through the jealousy of the chief authorities of the island," that "his servant or attendant, Duncan Beton, escaped a similar fate through the interposition of a young girl named Grant, whom he afterwards married, and by whom he had two sons, John and Duncan."

These two sons were sent to Glasgow for their education. The eldest became abbot of Mull, the second became the pupil of a

celebrated Irish physician, named Olahow. While Duncan still remained in Glasgow with his master, Olahow, an Isla man visited the latter, carrying a twig in his hand—upon his being questioned why he did so and where he got it, he replied, that he had cut it in Gruimeart in Isla, on a bank named Coadan, where a white serpent was to be found. Upon which Olahow called his pupil, Duncan Beton, and directed him to proceed to the place and secure the white serpent,—which he would boil, and secure the liquor in a glass bottle—this Beton performed, but in boiling the liquid a drop being likely to escape, he pushed it back with his finger, which burned it so much, that he put it into his mouth to soothe the pain.

He returned to Glasgow with the bottle to his master, who at once declared it deficient by one drop. Beton explained how this was, upon which Olahow declared he had become master of the secret, and congratulated him on his success.

Beton immediately began his practice, and with such success, that his reputation reaching the ears of the King, he was sent for, and had the luck to cure his Majesty, who desired him to name his reward; he said he presumed to ask the five merk lands of Monegh, Conant, now Ballinbay, which were granted to him.

The similarity of the stories handed down in these two remarkable traditions, curiously connected with legal documents, gives rise to some interesting questions as to the value of such traditions. In this case they have remained perfect for near 500 years—the coincidence in point of date assigned to the arrival of Cockspur in Isla, 1370, and the date of the grant by Alexander Stewart, the Wolf of Badenoch, immediately previous to 1379, is striking. But the prevalence of such traditions for so long a period in districts so far removed from each other, having so little intercourse together during the above period, leads to the inference that they are founded upon some tradition older than either.

Is there any such tradition traceable either in Celtic or Scandinavian story? It has to be noticed that Duncan is the Isla, Ferchard is the northern name of Beton, and the latter, is the Charter name.
