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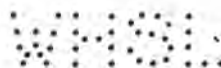

DOUGLAS MERRITT, Rhinebeck, N. Y.

1. WILLIAM SUTHERLAND, son of , born 1690, died about 1724, married Margaret . He and William Chambers had a grant of 1,000 acres south of Quassaick Creek, New Windsor, Col. Peter Matthews being the principal owner, 22 Sept., 1709. Sutherland receiving 250 acres on the south. Said to have died of consumption. Also said to have died in 1738, and his sons, William and John, inherited the patent lands. John sold his part to Nathan Smith, 1738. This must be another William. He and Margaret (Sodderland) were witnesses at baptism of Margrita Makdien, Dutch Church, Kingston, 1 July, 1711. He mortgaged 250 acres to John Ellison of New York, for £160, 26 Nov., 1718, and for £140 in 1721. Ellison took the land 8 May, 1723. Taxed on £45 at Marlborough 20 Jan., 1715 and 1718.

2. DAVID SUTHERLAND, son of William, born , died 1778, before 1728, married Mary, daughter of Patrick MacGregorie of Highlands, Orange Co. He had deed of 100 acres adjoining MacGregorie's house, given by MacGregorie 9 Aug., 1724 (Goshen Deeds, Lib. B, p. 290). Taxpayer, 1724. Freeholder, 1728. Bought 100 acres near Bethlehem from Dr. John Nicoll in 1734. Lieutenant of 5th Co., Fort Regiment, Orange Co., 20 June, 1738. At Cornwall, 1765. Lived on the Sackett place near Cornwall. A stone marked D. S. & M. S. is now in the wall of Mrs. Conklin's place. Signed Association for Rebellion in 1775. Made his will 27 Feb., 1769; proved 3 Nov., 1778 (New York, Lib. 33). Taxed Marlborough, 1725-9.

Will of DAVID SUTHERLAND of New Cornwall, yeoman. Gives household effects and use of estate to wife for life; homestead of 240 acres and 100 acres (being part of Capt. John Lawrence patent, bought of John Nicoll) to three sons, Andrew 50 acres adjoining Andrew's land bought of David Mandeville; David 35 acres adjoining land of Patrick McDaniels; Alexander the remainder except 35 acres to grandson Charles when of age. If Charles dies his share to go to granddaughters Mary and Jane, daughters of Patrick deceased. Charles to have 20 shillings and to be taught a trade when fifteen years old. Daughters, Jane, wife of Wm. Edminster £10; Letitia, wife of Moses Clerk, £10; Mary, wife of Robert Farrier, £5. Mentions Margaret, widow of son Patrick. Burial ground on his farm to be kept as a Sutherland burial place. Executors: wife Mary, sons Andrew and Alexander. (New York, Lib. 33.)

ANDREW SUTHERLAND, son of David, born March, 1728, died married Elizabeth Board, sister of Joseph, daughter of Cornelius and Elizabeth. He was born and lived at the point of Butter Hill (Historical Paper No. XI, p. 904). He had deed of land in Orange Co. from Robert Ferris, 1 July, 1765 (Goshen, Lib. C, p. 238, 13 Sept., 1768). He had deed of 29½ acres adjoining David Sutherland, Sr., at New Cornwall from David Mandeville for £88, 1 Sept., 1767. In this deed Andrew is called of Pompton, N. J. Signed Revolutionary Association 1775. Had a mortgage for £175 from Gideon Coleman, 3 June, 1793 (Lib. C, p. 94). Mortgage from Patrick Sutherland, 5 July, 1793 (Goshen, Lib. C, p. 92). Mortgage from William Conkling for £101, 6 Sept., 1786 (Goshen, Lib. B, p. 97). Made his will, 11 Sept., 1794. (Historical Paper, XI, 1904.)

Deed Made Sept. 1st 1767 in the 7th year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third, King of Great Britain France & Ireland &c. Between David Mandeville of the Precinct of New Cornwall County of Orange & Province of New York, Yeoman of the one part, and Andrew Southerland of Pumptown in the County of Bergen and Province of East New Jersey, Gentleman, of the second part. Conveys to said Andrew Southerland for the sum of eighty eight pounds, ten shillings current money of New York, twenty nine & a half acres of land situate in the Precinct of New Cornwall & County of Orange aforesaid, being part of a lot of land whereon the said David Mandeville now lives. Beginning at a sapling &c. standing on the South side of a brook in or near the North east bounds of the lands of David Southerland Senr. and thence (boundaries here given).

Witnessed by David Southerland Senr. & David Sands. Deed signed by David Mandeville & Anna Mandeville.

Do not find when it was recorded but it was probably on the back of the deed, but as it has been pasted on a piece of muslin I cannot see it.

DAVID SUTHERLAND, son of David, born 1743, died , married Hannah, daughter of . He had deed of 95 acres adjoining David Mandeville and William Peet in Orange Co. for £170, from Thomas Sutherland of Dutchess Co., 19 Aug., 1761. He was Constable, 1775, called junior. Signed Association, 1775. Mortgaged land to Cadwallader Colden for £205, 4 June, 1776 (Goshen, Lib. A, p. 227). Gave deed of land in Cornwall to Patrick Sutherland, 10 March, 1784 (Goshen, Lib. D, p. 229). Had deed of land in New Cornwall from Thomas and Susanna Howe, 29 Aug., 1797 (Goshen, Lib. F, p. 227). Mortgaged land to Henry Cropsey for \$309, 11 June, 1798 (Goshen, Lib. D, p. 99). Made his will 25 June, 1799. He was buried in the Friends' Cemetery.

I, David Southerland, of the town of Cornwall, in the County of Orange and State of New York, being weak in body, but of sound mind and memory, and calling to mind the mortality of the body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and constitute this my last will and testament in manner and form following:

1st. I order and direct that my body be decently interred in Friends' Burying Ground at Cornwall by the side of my deceased wife under the direction and care of my executors hereinafter named.

2nd. I order and direct that my funeral charges and just debts be punctually paid out of the monies hereinafter mentioned for that purpose.

3rd.—I give to my daughter, Latisha Moor, wife of William Moor, twelve acres of land off the north end of the land which I purchased of the Morels laying on the west side of the road leading from Cornwall landing to Smiths Clove, beginning at Patrick Southerland's garden fence and runs thence southeasterly along said road so far as to include said twelve acres of land by drawing a straight line to the land of Henry and Zebulon Townsend; also three acres of wood land off the easterly end of the land given to me by my father, David Southerland, deceased. * * *

4th.—I give to my daughter, Jane Norvill, wife of George Norvill * * * all the remainder of my land included between the land which I have given to my daughter, Latisha, and a piece of land which I sold to my son, William, including all my land laying on the east side of the road before mentioned, whereon her house stands; also three acres of wood land joining to the wood land which I gave to my daughter Latisha. * * *

5th.—I give to my son, Joseph Southerland, all the remainder of that piece of land, which was given to me by my father, David Southerland, including the road excepted in a deed which I gave to my son, Joseph, and I gave my gun to his son, David Southerland.

6th.—I give to my son, William, all the remainder of the tract of land, which I bought of the Morels, except four acres of wood land off the southwesterly end thereof. * * *

7th.—I give to my daughter, Precilly Hanvy, wife of Joseph Hanvy, fifteen acres of land off the south end of my homestead whereon I now live, to begin at the westerly corner of my land, joining the land of Samuel Arthur, and to run thence easterly along the road from Sutton's mill to Cornwall Landing one-third part off the width of my land on said road and then to run northeasterly on a parallel line with the land of Samuel Arthur so far as to include just fifteen acres of land. * *

8th.—I give to my daughter, Sarah, fifteen acres of land along side of that which I have given to my daughter, Precilly, extending the same width on the road as the land does and running so far in length as to include said fifteen acres of land. * * *

9th.—I give to my daughter, Susanna, fifteen acres of land, joining the land which I have given to my daughter, Sarah, extending along said road until it comes to the land now in possession of Edwin Sands; thence northerly along said land until it comes to the brook, then along said brook but not to include any privilege that may be useful for erecting any kind of water works that may be erected on the east side of said brook, so far as to include said fifteen acres of land. * * *

10th.—I give to my son, Jesse Southerland and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the remaining part of my homestead, also four acres of woodland which I reserved off the southwesterly end of the tract which I bought of the Morels. * * *

11th.—I order and direct that my two daughters, Jane and Latisha, their heirs and assigns, have free liberty to pass through the land given to my son, Joseph, for the purpose of using and occupying their land along on the southwest side thereof by the line of the land belonging to Thomas Brown. * * *

12th.—I order and direct that my son, Jesse, his heirs and assigns, have free liberty to pass through the land which I have given to my son, William, where it may be convenient and do the least damage, for the purpose of using and improving the four acres of wood land which I have left to the said Jesse. * * *

13th.—I order and direct that my Joseph pay the sum of forty pounds, my son, William, pay the sum of forty-five pounds, to be applied towards the payment of my just debts and funeral charges.

I nominate and appoint William Titus and William Townsend and King Rider, executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine.

PATRICK MACGREGORIE, born _____, in Scotland; served in the English Army, in France, under Charles I. On his return he took part in the religious controversy in 1681-2, and finally was chosen as leader of a number of Presbyterians who landed at the Capes of Virginia after an eight weeks' passage from Scotland, probably Aberdeen, in July, 1684, and proceeded by land to New Jersey. The company consisted of himself, his brother-in-law, David Toshack, David Maskrig, McCollum and possibly David Sutherland. MacGregorie wrote to Scotland from Perth Amboy, Nov., 1684. They were Proprietors of East Jersey, owning 4,000 acres. Toshack, who was a partner of the Earl of Perth, died intestate, and Major MacGregorie was appointed administrator, 28 April, 1688. MacGregorie was muster general of militia under Gov. Dongan, and was sent on a mission to the French Indians, who captured and took him to Montreal. Returning, he took part in the Leister revolution and was killed at Fort George, 19 March, 1691. Leaving wife Margaret, sons Hugh, John, Patrick, and daughters Catherine Evans and Jane Lawrence. Baptized, Dutch Church, Kingston, N. Y., 7 Jan., 1687, Johannes, son of Patric Magrigny and Margaret Thousby. Witnesses: Thomas Chambers and Lauretta Kellenæer. His father-in-law is said to have been Capt. John Evans. His widow petitioned for restoration of the title of her husband's land in 1710, and Patrick, Jr., was granted 160 acres, 9 Aug., 1720, beginning at southeast corner of land of William Sutherland. Patrick, Jr., made the following deed to his daughter, Mary, and son-in-law, David Sutherland.

All that certain tract of land situated, lying and being in the county of Orange being part of a certain tract of land containing five hundred acres granted to me the said Patrick Margrigory under the broad seal of this province, now the above said given and granted tract begins att a white oak tree marked on foore sides with three notchis standing on the line of Colonel Ingolnbeys land near the Butter Hill and from thence running sooth sixty degrees west twenty chains and forty two links thence northwest fifty chains and then north sixty degrees east twenty chains and forty two links thence sooth east fifty chains to the place where begun.

Together with all the right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever which I now have or which any or either of my heirs, executors administrators and assigns may hereafter have of to or in the said granted premises or any part thereof. To have and to hold the above recited tract of land containing one hundred acres the southwest bounds thereof being distant from the dwelling hoose of me the said Patrick Margrigory aboot five chains and a half, with all the appurtenances there with belonging unto them the said David Sotherland and Mary his wife their heirs executors administrators and assigns forever absolutely without any manner of conditions (except) they paying of the quit rent of the said one hundred acres proportionally to the quit rent of the patent of me the said Patrick Margrigory refference being thereunto had more fully and at large appear.

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN. The 13th day of March one thousand seven hundred & ninety-four. I, David Sutherland, of Washington town, Dutchess County, and State of New York being of perfect mind, memory, thanks be given unto God therefore, calling unto mind, the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, I do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament—That is to say, principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul unto the hand of God that gave It, and my body I recommend to the earth, to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors, not doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again, of the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to help me in this life, I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form—I first order an inventory of all my movable estate and that to be equally divided between my daughters, Hannah, Judith, Mary, Anne and the four sons of Sarah, deceased, to be made equal to one of the other daughters.

I further give and bequeath to my beloved wife what she brought with her and her wearing apparel, and a horse saddle and bridle valued at thirty pounds and a bed and bedding if she makes* it, which things are to be taken out, before the movables are divided.

Further I give to my wife one hundred pounds payable in one year after my decease, except, if she requests a sufficient supply to bear her expenses to her children, to be paid sooner—which sum is to be delivered instead of her dower; not to be paid till she legally quit claims her title of dower, to my estate, to the Heirs of my body.

Also ten pounds each to the four sons of my daughter, Sarah, deceased, payable in one year after my decease. The above legacies to be paid out of the moneys arising from the sale of the lands, and the remainder to be equally divided between my three sons except one-fifth of one-third part of David's part, I give to Henry, David's Son.

Also I set my negro girl, Dinah, free, as the law directs—and I do appoint my executors and empower them to sell or divide the lands as may best suit the heirs and also settle, receive and pay all my just debts, Solomon Sutherland, William R. Sutherland, Nathan Canfield, executors of this my last Will and Testament—I order that the above executors be paid for all their reasonable trouble and expense, out of moneys arising from the lands, likewise my negro Roger be maintained by my sons free upon equal expense.

N. B. Before he signed and delivered above testament, the sentences (till she quit claims her title of dower to my estate to the heirs of my body) was interlined between 14th, 15th and 16th lines.

STATEMENT ATTACHED TO THE WILL.

The testator died a day or two subsequent to the execution of the Will. When the Will was opened the husbands of the daughters expressed great dissatisfaction over the distribution of the Estate made by the Will and some of them in examining the Will then declared that it gave to the sons only a life estate in the lands.

* So in Will. Probably word meant is *wants*.

In consequence of this dissatisfaction and to avoid any litigation with respect to the validity of the Will it is believed that it was agreed among all the heirs to divide the estate without reference to the Will. The sons to take all the property real and personal and to pay the daughters a specific sum of money. Accordingly the Will was never proved, and the executors never qualified, although in doing the business of the Estate they stile themselves executors. They paid each of the daughters a sum of money acknowledged to be greater than their share of the movable estate given them by the Will was worth. And each of them with their husbands gave receipts similar to that attached to the copy of the Will. The sons made partition of the real estate and entered into the immediate possession of it.

The negro man, Roger whose maintenance is made a personal charge upon the sons, was at the time of the death of the testator about one hundred years old and survived the testator ten or twelve years—supported entirely by the sons—The questions arising from this Will and on which Mr. Henry's written opinion is requested are:

1st. Does this Will give to the sons an estate in fee or for life only in the lands?

2nd. If an estate for life only does or does not the composition which was made and the receipts which were given amount to an agreement on the part of the daughters that the sons shall take the lands in fee and will a Court of Equity compel them to execute releases?

(Attached to the papers is the following which evidently is the answer given by Mr. Henry to these questions relating to the construction of the Will of David Sutherland.)

1st. I think the sons have an absolute estate of inheritance in the lands because the legacies were payable not out of the rents and proceeds, but out of the moneys to arise from the sale of the lands. Because the sons were charged, personally, with the maintenance of the negro, Roger for his life. Because the money to arise from the sale of the lands was to be theirs absolutely and by necessary intention the interest in the lands was to be co-equal. The same inference is to be drawn from the power given to the executors, to sell or divide the lands as may best suit the heirs. Had this power been exercised by sale, the moneys must have been paid to the sons, unconditionally; and if by division of the lands, it must have been by a division correlative with the estate in the money.

2nd. If this should not be the true construction of the Will, it is doubtful, whether a Court of Equity would enforce the agreement between said daughters and their husbands and the sons. Probably, no more would be done than to put the daughters to their election, either to restore the money and take under the Will, or else, to confirm the estate in fee in the sons. The answer upon this subject, however, is unimportant as it appears to me decisively that the inheritance passed under the Will.

Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Foster for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings, current money of New York to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Sooterland the receipt whereof he dooth hereby acknowledge, hath bargained and sold and by these presents dooth bargain & sell unto the said Joseph Sooterland,

All that moity or one half part of that a certain lot and parcell of land situate and being in Orange Coonty aforesaid, beginning at a red oak tree standing near the Murtherers Creek near Sloop Hill at the easterly side thereof and runs from the said tree (being marked on four sides with three notches) sooth forty three degrees west in and a long the line of land belonging to the children of David Mandefield late of Orange Coonty aforesaid deceased one hundred and six chains, then sooth east seventeen chains and fifty links the north forty five degrees east one hundred and five chains to the Murtherers Creek aforesaid near the mooth thereof and from thence along the said creek to the red oak tree aforesaid the place where the same lot and parcel of land first began, containing one hundred and ninety acres or there aboots as the same was surveyed and layed out by Robert Crook and is bounded on the north east by the Murtherers Creek aforesaid, on the north west by the aforesaid childrens land on the sooth west by land belonging to Mis Ingoldesby and sooth east by the land of John Picke and is commonly knowen and distinguished by lot number (five) as by a drawg or plan thereof made among other lands under the hand of the said Robert Crook bearing date the twelfth day of December one thousand seven hundred twenty & seven relation being there unto had may more fully appear.

To have and to hold the said lot and parcel of land and mill & all and singular the premises herein mentioned and intended to be hereby bargained and sold with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Joseph Sootherland his executors, administrators and assigns from the day before the date hereof for and during the term of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be complete and ended (except only as before excepted) yealding and paying therefore yearly rent of one pepar corn at the Feast of St. Michael the Arch Angel only if the same be lawfully demanded to the intent that by virtue of these present and of the statute for transferring of uses into possession, the said Joseph Sootherland may be in the actual possession of the premises and be enabled to except a grant of the reversion and inheritance thereof to him and his heirs.

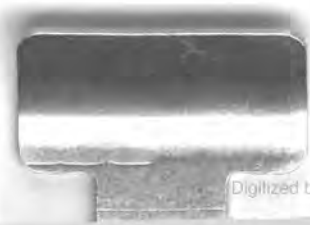
